For a small school of 135 pupils we have had a wonderful year of success and achievement in Mullavilly Primary School. We celebrate all of our boys and girls success inside and outside of school.

Football

The boys and girls football team have had a remarkable year, winning a total of 4 tournaments and playing an exciting brand of football. The boys team were made up entirely of Primary 6's which makes their performance even more impressive. Some of the successes have included:

- Winning the Jones Shield qualifying tournament with 4 wins from 4.
- Winning the second Mid Ulster League Festival Day against 24 other schools.
- Winning the Hamiltonsbawn football tournament.
- Winning the P6 Brownlow Cup.
- Girls winning the Richmount 5 a side tournament.
- Reaching the semi-finals of two other tournaments.

In total the football teams played 41 matches, won 29, drew 8 and lost just 4.
