Dear Parents,

We are delighted to be back to face to face teaching in the classroom. As we commence Term 3 there are just a few things I would like to draw your attention to.

Due to Covid guidelines Mrs Jackson will be starting her maternity leave early and Miss Cochrane will be teaching the Primary 3 class on a Monday and a Tuesday. Miss Cochrane is also employed in the school on a Wednesday and Thursday as part of the Engage Programme and will be working with groups of pupils from the Primary 3 class.

I would like to remind all parents that we are still using the Seesaw App for homeworks. It is essential parents check their child's Seesaw account and submit homeworks via this platform for teachers to mark. Teachers will also post reminders and class notifications on Seesaw.



As stated in a previous notification there are a lot of unreturned reading books. Please check carefully at home and send these back to school as soon as possible.

I would like to remind parents of our Healthy Break policy. As Mullavilly Primary School is a "Health Promoting School" we ask that only the following foods and liquids are consumed at break time: fruit, vegetables, crackers, yoghurt, cheese or a sandwich. Only water and milk should be provided in water bottles. On Fridays only children are permitted to have crisps, a biscuit or a small bar of chocolate, sweets are not allowed. I would also like to remind parents to check all food that is sent to school. Food that contain nuts or may contain peanuts are not permitted.



Over the course of the next few weeks we are getting some building work done to the school, which involves the removal of the rendering at the front and side of the school. Scaffolding will be erected and workmen will be on site. This will cause some disruption at drop of and pick up times as the staff carpark will be closed. Please be understanding during this time and supervise all children whilst on school premises.
