

How to complete a comprehension activity with your child!

When reading, encourage children to draw on knowledge of vocabulary to understand text, identify and explain key aspects of fiction and non-fiction text, identify and explain the sequence of events, make inferences and predict on the basis of what has been read so far.

- 1) Read through the text together. Ask questions around what the text is about.

Use the attached prompts to help you with this.

- 2) Read each question one at a time, marking key words. Consider where in the text to look for your answer. (Scan the text to find words, where appropriate.) Carefully re-read to find your answer.
- 3) Talk about how the evidence from the text helps answer the question.
- 4) Use the question and information in the text to create a full answer.

E.g. Where is the boy hiding? The boy is hiding _____

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
